EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME

The United Kingdom is due to leave the European Union on 31 October 2019. The Catholic Church in England and Wales stands in solidarity with all EU citizens who have made their home here, many of whom are an integral and valued part of our parishes, schools and communities, including here in the Diocese of Nottingham. The law concerning the free movement of people will be changing and **EU, EEA & Swiss citizens must apply to the settlement scheme** if they are to protect their existing rights and place in our society. DRAFT PASTORAL PLAN FOR THE SHERWOOD DEANERY

Following our own parish meeting on Tuesday the 23 July 2019, which was well attended, our Dean Fr Michael O'Donoghue has asked us to make the following statement: The Dean wishes to thank the clergy and the people in their parishes who have reflected on The Draft Deanery Pastoral Plan. The responses from the parishes were shared and discussed by the clergy on Thursday 25 July. It was agreed to appoint a facilitator who will collate the responses. The comments will be used to revise the draft Sherwood Deanery Pastoral Plan and be presented to Bishop Patrick by September 2019. His thoughts and recommendations will be relayed to us for further refinement so that we can build a sustainable structure for the church in the area. Five priests will be allocated to Sherwood Deanery by 2021 based on the present age profile and health of the clergy.
