The United Kingdom is due to leave the European Union on 31 October 2019. The Catholic Church in England and Wales stands in solidarity with all EU citizens who have made their home here, many of whom are an integral and valued part of our parishes, schools and communities, including here in the Diocese of Nottingham. The law concerning the free movement of people will be changing and **EU, EEA & Swiss citizens must apply to the settlement scheme** if they are to protect their existing rights and place in our society.
