Read the New Testament in a year: With just 3-4 minutes reading a day it's quite possible to read through the whole of the New Testament in a year. A reading plan running from Advent 2019 to Advent 2020 has been prepared and is available on our website and at the back of churches. We'll also publish the readings week by week on the back of the newsletter.

Epiphany House Blessing: It is traditional on the Feast of Epiphany for the faithful to take blessed chalk from Mass and bless their homes by writing above the front door. When you've finished, the writing above your door should look like this - **20 † C † M † B † 20** - it is written in a specific order whilst saying the prayer below:

'In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

'The three Wise Men, Caspar (**C**), Melchior (**M**), and Balthazar (**B**) followed the star of God's Son who became man two thousand (**20**) and twenty years ago (**20**). May Christ bless our home (**† †**) and remain with us throughout the new year (**† †**). Amen.

'May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek to serve Christ in everyone we meet. Amen.'

The 20 & 20 refers to the year, the C, M & B refers to names of the Magi, but also stands for 'Christus mansionem benedicat,' which means, 'May Christ bless this house.'
