Mansfield Food bank: Hello to everyone. Hope you are all well after the most difficult and challenging of times for everyone! This however also brought and demonstrated the huge levels of community spirit shown across the country and our local community of Mansfield. On that note, I would like to express my gratitude on behalf of Mansfield Foodbank and especially those who have benefited from your donations. That being said we are now operating a somewhat reduced service providing packed lunches and emergency food parcels to those struggling from benefit delays etc. We are unclear currently how the situation is going to develop, particularly through loss of income possibly when the furlough scheme comes to an end. We are therefore asking for your continued support in providing in date items of tinned hot meats, vegetables including potatoes, fruit, rice pudding, cereals, cold meat, fish, pasta sauces and toiletries are always in demand. Targeted items such as those above enable an individual family to produce some sort of meal. Baked beans, spaghetti and soup are also of use. On a positive note, many rough sleepers have been housed and are receiving some support, but find it difficult to manage and we are seeing people struggling for a period of time. A bag of food items will often get them through a week due to benefit delays or there is crisis before their next payment may be due. Thank you and take care. Lu.

Fr Paul is a native of Newcastle-on-Tyne and I have known Fr Paul for 12 years, as he was a parishioner of mine in Lincoln. Fr Paul was ordained for our Diocese in January 2019. Social distancing requirements mean we can only have a limited number of people in church at any one time, and we must keep a record for 21 days of who has been at each Mass for track and test purposes. We are using the diocesan booking system on www.massbooking.uk to pre-book our places at Mass. Remember, there is still no obligation to attend Mass on Sundays.

Open for Mass: To book a pew for Mass at St Philip Neri please visit the diocesan booking website, www.massbooking.uk. If you're struggling contact the parish office and Catherine will be able to help you make your booking. Booking at St Philip Neri is by pew, rather than individual. You are not booking your place but booking a pew in your name for your whole household. On the diocesan booking system you will be presented with two options, either to book a 'family pew' or an 'individual place.' Please note that each books a pew, large or small depending on the choice, so book according to the space you need rather than the number of individuals coming. Here's a guide to what to book depending on how many of you are coming:

- **1 individual** - please book an individual place.
- **3 or more people from the same household** - please book a family pew
- **2 people from the same household** - please book either a family pew or one individual place. On the diocesan booking website, it will tell you that 'couples can book either a pew or two seats.' Please don't follow this guidance! Either book a pew or one seat.

A 'family pew' at St Philip's will accommodate a household of up to 8 people comfortably, an 'individual space' will accommodate a household of up to two people. Please don't hesitate to be in touch if you have any questions. The important thing to note is that each booking represents a pew. Unless you are booking for multiple households there should be no need to enter any number other than '1' when booking.
