GENERAL NOTICES

The following advice is given by the Government

Communal worship and life events - You can leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, a funeral or event related to a death, a burial ground or a remembrance garden, or to attend a wedding ceremony. You should follow the [guidance on the safe use of places of worship](#) and must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship, weddings, funerals and religious, belief-based or commemorative events linked to someone's death are all subject to limits on the numbers that can attend and weddings may only take place in exceptional circumstances. This advice means that Mass, during this period of Tier 5 Lockdown, will continue to be celebrated in the socially distanced manner to which we have become accustomed. Please continue to book for Mass as per normal.

Funerals will continue to be restricted to only 30 mourners. Only 6 including the parents and Godparents are allowed to be present at a baptism. There are further restrictions on the celebration of weddings. Only 6 people can be present at weddings in Tier 4 and Tier 5 areas. In the event of us going down to Tier 1, 2 or 3, then 15 people are allowed to be present at a wedding. Thanks to all our stewards who ensure that we worship safely in our churches.

Update on Covid-19 and Vaccination: In September 2020 the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales issued a statement [COVID-19 and Vaccination](#) (24 September 2020). In the light of the recent breakthrough in vaccine development they have now issued a follow up statement (3rd December 2020) which can be found on the CBCEW website along with the original September statement.
