GENERAL NOTICES

The following advice is given by the Government. Communal worship and life events -You can leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, a funeral or event related to a death, a burial ground or a remembrance garden, or to attend a wedding ceremony in exceptional circumstances. You should follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship. Weddings, funerals and religious, belief-based or commemorative events linked to someone's death are all subject to limits on the numbers that can attend and weddings may only take place in exceptional circumstances.

This advice means that Mass, during this period of Tier 5 Lockdown, will continue to be celebrated in the socially distanced manner to which we have become accustomed. Please continue to book for Mass as per normal. Funerals will continue to be restricted to only 30 mourners. There are further restrictions on the celebration of weddings. Only 6 people can be present at weddings in Tier 4 and Tier 5 areas. In the event of us going down to Tier 1, 2 or 3, then 15 people are allowed to be present at a wedding. Thanks to all our stewards who ensure that we worship safely in our churches.

National Day of Reflection for COVID-19 on Tuesday 23 March:

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have asked that we join with the Prime Minister and have a National Day of Reflection to mark the anniversary of the 1st National Lockdown. The country will be asked to respect a minute silence at midday and doorstep vigil of light at 8.00pm. We as Catholics are also asked to make this a day of prayer. Our three churches that are presently open will be open for private prayer, when the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at various times during the day. Please do make a note of these times and visit one of our churches if you can and remember the following intentions:

- 1. We reflect in sorrow on all those who have died.
- 2. We reflect in compassion on all those who have suffered during the last year, whether through illness, stress, financial difficulty or family tension.
- 3. We reflect in thanksgiving for the generosity, inventiveness, self-sacrifice and determination shown by so many in this difficult of times.
- 4. We reflect in hope, that, as the pandemic is controlled and we open up our lives again, we will gather in the lessons we have learned and build our society into a better shape, more compassionate, less marked by inequalities, more responsive to needs and deprivation.

Please remember to book for all Masses using the Diocesan booking system on our website. Social distancing requirements mean we can only have a limited number of people in churches at any one time, and we must keep a record for 21 days of who has been at each Mass for track and trace purposes. For all our churches we are using the diocesan booking system on www.massbooking.uk to pre-book our places at Mass. Face masks to be worn and 2mtr distancing to be observed at all times. When booking a pew, you will be presented with 2 options, either a 'family pew' or an 'individual place'.

At St Joseph's and St Teresa's, a 'family pew' will accommodate up to 4 people.

At St Philip Neri, it will accommodate up to 6 people.

At St Joseph's and St Teresa's an 'individual place' will be for 1 person. At St Philip Neri the space will accommodate 2 people from the same household.
