Communal worship and life events -** You can leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, a funeral or event related to a death, a burial ground or a remembrance garden, or to attend a wedding ceremony. You should follow the [guidance on the safe use of places of worship](#) and must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship. Weddings, funerals and religious, belief-based or commemorative events linked to someone's death are all subject to limits on the numbers that can attend. This advice means that Mass, during this time, will continue to be celebrated in the socially distanced manner to which we have become accustomed. Please continue to book for Mass as per normal. Funerals will continue to be restricted to only 30 mourners. There are further restrictions on the celebration of weddings. Only 6 people can attend at present. Thanks to all our stewards who ensure that we worship safely in our churches.

Adult sizes are £3 and children's £2 each. Fabric design and colours will vary. All money will go to church funds. **Mansfield Foodbank:** Hello everyone. I hope you are all well and looking forward to a more positive time soon. Once again, thank you from everyone who continues to benefit from your huge generosity and continued support! We are still, despite the majority of homeless now in some sort of housing, continuing to see people on a regular basis. They are still in need of basic food parcels, and we continue to provide packed lunches. Last week we saw around 30 people! For many it is a bit of a small lifeline, but is a "sticking plaster" over some of the bigger issues which surround them. As we are still working under challenging circumstances, conversation of the type we would previously been able to have, are difficult on many levels. Conversation for some is vital to establish what is going on at that time. We continue to try to support a local school, in order that they can support families in a small way by operating their own weekly Foodbank for an hour each week. Donations are still therefore, most welcome in particular, long life milk, cereal, biscuits, tinned hot and cold meat and vegetables. Many of the housed previously homeless/rough sleepers seem only to be able to eat cereal for a variety of reasons! However, anything is always most welcome! Love Lu

**Please remember to book for all Masses using the Diocesan booking system on our website.** Social distancing requirements mean we can only have a limited number of people in churches at any one time, and we must keep a record for 21 days of who has been at each Mass for track and trace purposes. **For all our churches we are using the diocesan booking system on [www.massbooking.uk](http://www.massbooking.uk) to pre-book our places at Mass. Face masks to be worn and 2mtr distancing to be observed at all times.** When booking a pew, you will be presented with 2 options, either a 'family pew' or an 'individual place'.

At St Joseph's and St Teresa's, a 'family pew' will accommodate up to 4 people.

At St Philip Neri, it will accommodate up to 6 people.

At St Joseph's and St Teresa's an 'individual place' will be for 1 person. At St Philip Neri the space will accommodate 2 people from the same household.
