GENERAL NOTICES

Following changes to the Government guidelines, I have met with our community Core groups and with St Philip’s Parish Pastoral Council and having studied guidance from the Bishops of England and Wales, we have made the following decisions. We will continue to have our churches socially distanced and we will continue to use the diocesan booking system for all Masses. Masks will continue to be worn in church. Our new socially distanced capacities for our churches are: St Philip Neri – 100, St Joseph – 40, St Teresa – 40

Our attendance at “life-cycle” ceremonies will continue to be by family invitation only and will be limited to the socially distanced capacity of each church. These decisions will be reviewed in mid-September. I am grateful as always for the wonderful support of all our stewards who ensure safety in our churches. Fr John

Parish Changes: Bishop Patrick has announced changes to parish structures and priests’ responsibilities. The Bishop made his decisions following the consultation process that had taken place prior to the pandemic.

Firstly, the churches of St Bernadette, Bolsover and St George, Rainworth, will not now reopen.

The parish of St Patrick, Forest Town will, from September, be served by the clergy of St Philip Neri, Mansfield, with Fr John being appointed Parish Priest.

Fr Paul Smith will leave to take up a new appointment in September and his position in the parish will be taken by Fr Marc Besana, who is moving here from his present post at St Edward’s, Nottingham.

The Bishop’s letter has been circulated by email and on the parish WhatsApp group. Hard copies are available in all our churches.

Fr Paul Smith: Fr Paul also announced that he has been allowed by Bishop Patrick to leave the Diocese of Nottingham to return home to the Diocese of Hexham and Newcastle, in order to be close to his family and particularly his mother who has been unwell for some time. I would like to thank Fr Paul for his companionship and hard work in the most challenging of situations owing to Covid regulations. I know he has found it most difficult to get to know our parishes as he would have hoped. On behalf of us all I offer my prayers and good wishes for his future ministry in the North-East. BOOK FOR MASS - WWW.MASSBOOKING.UK

For all our churches we are using the diocesan booking system on www.massbooking.uk to pre-book our places at Mass. Face masks to be worn and distancing to be observed at all times. When booking a pew, you will be presented with 2 options, either a ‘family pew’ or an ‘individual place’. At St Joseph’s and St Teresa’s, a ‘family pew’ will accommodate up to 4 people. At St Philip Neri, it will accommodate up to 6 people. At St Joseph’s and St Teresa’s an ‘individual place’ will be for 1 person. At St Philip Neri this space will accommodate 2 people from the same household.

CAFOD: A few weeks ago, we were reminded that it is 6 years since Pope Francis wrote his encyclical *Laudato Si*. Perhaps in that time you have had an opportunity to think about what personal response you can make to Pope Francis' request to consider the "Cry of the Earth and the Cry of the Poor". Over the next few months some ideas will be suggested for you to try or consider trying in your own lives, some may be big and not for you, others may be easy changes which you could try to introduce into your lives, many you may already be doing without realising that you are helping. Whichever applies please do try something new to help our planet which will help the poorest people. 1st idea to work on is the way we use plastic. This could be a big one so consider: Reuse, Recycle, Buy alternatives e.g. card. The good news is that soft plastic like bread bags can now be recycled in our local Co-op stores.
