For all our churches we are using the diocesan booking system on www.massbooking.uk to pre-book our places at Mass. Face masks to be worn and distancing to be observed at all times. When booking a pew, you will be presented with 2 options, either a 'family pew' or an 'individual place'. At St Joseph's and St Teresa's, a 'family pew' will accommodate up to 4 people. At St Philip Neri, it will accommodate up to 6 people. At St Joseph's and St Teresa's an 'individual place' will be for 1 person. At St Philip Neri this space will accommodate 2 people from the same household.

Mansfield Foodbank: Hello to everyone in the St Philip's Church family. Firstly, may I apologise for the lateness with the update on the Foodbank. Thank you all again for your amazing donations, as always, which continue to support many vulnerable people each week. Currently, our numbers are still high and we are still providing substantial packed lunches to a large group of people with varying needs and issues. The status of the Foodbank and its future is still very much of an insecure nature, as we wait to find out the future of the Methodist Church and its forthcoming sale. This impacts upon us as we rent a building from the church. I will of course keep you updated on progress as-and-when it happens. However, donations are still very much welcomed in the form you have been providing of meat, fish, vegetables, fruit, beans, soup, biscuits, milk, cereal, etc. Although, as always, anything however small is greatly received as donations have become limited. September may see an increase in need as universal credit is reduced for many.
