Save the Day: Save the Planet: More news on our Season of Creation prayer service [Sunday 19 September](#). The service will begin at 3.00pm on the school field of St Philip Neri with St Bede Catholic Voluntary Academy, Rosemary Street, Mansfield. This can be accessed from the Tesco car park. The children in our three primary schools are learning the same two songs for the service and are keen to have a chance to sing together at last. The service is ecumenical and is for anyone in the area to celebrate creation and commit to caring for the earth during this special time. After there will be an opportunity to have a picnic on the school field and a chance to talk with people whom we haven't seen before or for a long time creating new and renewing old friendships. Please bring a picnic and something to sit on such as a chair or blanket. If the weather is not good, it is also ok to bring a small shelter or popup marquee.

For all our churches we are using the diocesan booking system on www.massbooking.uk to pre-book our places at Mass. Face masks to be worn and distancing to be observed at all times. When booking a pew, you will be presented with 2 options, either a 'family pew' or an 'individual place'. At St Joseph's and St Teresa's, a 'family pew' will accommodate up to 4 people. At St Philip Neri, it will accommodate up to 6 people. At St Joseph's and St Teresa's an 'individual place' will be for 1 person. At St Philip Neri this space will accommodate 2 people from the same household.
