- Buy less

Reduce Waste food

- Only buy what food you can use eg. Buy a size of turkey suitable for the number of guests
- Use leftovers in another recipe
- Use the freezer for leftovers
- Make soup with vegetables left in the fridge at the end of the week.
- Use unexpected parts of vegetables eg stalks, outside leaves of cabbage, broccoli in soups and casseroles
- Understand the difference between sell by and sell by dates
- Use the sniff test, if food doesn't look bad or smell bad it can probably be eaten, just cook it for a bit longer.
