Following consultation with Parish Councils and Core Groups, we have come to the following decisions: We will continue to use the Diocesan booking system. Instead of booking an individual place or family pew you will be asked to book the number of seats you require for yourself or your family. Our churches will continue to be socially distanced.

Masks will continue to be worn in church. Our attendance at life-cycle ceremonies will continue to be by family invitation only and be limited to the socially distanced capacity of our churches.
