UPDATE - Journey towards one parish.... You may be aware that there has been a good deal of consultation happening in the Diocese with regard to the need to look at the number of priests and the number of Churches. The Sherwood deanery has already had some changes with regards to parishes losing their resident priest. The Deanery meeting in Newark on the 19 February, made it clear that parishes will have to amalgamate. On Thursday 5 May there was an initial meeting in St Philip Neri Church Hall of the PPC's of St Philip Neri and St Patrick's and the Core groups of St Joseph's and St Teresa's. The purpose of this meeting was to start exploring what we need to do to fulfil the request of the Diocese to amalgamate the communities in the Mansfield Pastoral Area into one parish. We will keep you informed of progress and any changes that will need to be made further to those we have already experienced. On Tuesday 24 May at 7pm at St Philip Neri Hall, we hosted a Deanery wide meeting with the Vicar General Canon Jarosz to further discuss the changes and consider what areas we need to look at to bring our parish together and at the same time, be missionary and reach out.

Working towards ONE Parish - June 2022

On Monday 20 June, 2022 representatives from each of the four communities –

St Joseph's – Ann Neale and Peter Whiteley; St Patrick's – Cory Marsh and Len Hutton

St Philip Neri - Clare Lund and Katie Wynn-Higgins; St Teresa's – David Pearson and Maggie Booth;

Fr John Kyne, Fr Marc Besana and Sr Susan Richert (co-ordinator of the Group) to begin looking at what we need to do as we move towards becoming one parish.

The first item was a new name for the new parish. A large number of suggestions were received from all the communities. However, there were a good number of suggestions focusing on two names –

ALL SAINTS and OUR LADY.

After careful thought and much discussion, it was decided that the name

Catholic Parish of Our Lady and All Saints

would be proposed. Fr John accepted this but pointed out that the final say belongs to Bishop Patrick.

The reasoning behind the choice was-

Our Lady because of Mary's connection in Mansfield – Ladybrook.. The well and brook, both once well known as Our Lady's well and brook, are still in existence. There is also a statue of Our Lady on the outside of the Church of St Philip Neri and our 4 schools are part of Our Lady of Lourdes CMAT. All Saints because the six churches and schools have different Saints' names and we are coming together.

As Church, St Paul refers to Believers as Saints (Rom. 1:7; Eph.1:1) In Nov. 2014, Pope Francis reminded us:

"it is by living with love and offering Christian witness in our daily tasks that we are called to become saints... Always and everywhere you can become a saint, that is, by being receptive to the grace that is working in us and leads us to holiness."

Other matters:

- Move to having ONE newsletter for all the communities
- The Website will be looked at and updated reflecting the communities; look at livestreaming Mass for those unable to attend Church
- There will be a meeting of all the Catechists to plan a way forward re catechist formation
- Explore developing the SVP
- Create ONE PPC for the new parish; create Core Groups which are open to anyone who wishes to join, in the other communities
- Fr John will call a meeting of the present Finance Committees and move towards creating ONE finance committee – and bringing all accounts together at the start of the next financial year.
- There will be a "sign-up" sheet distributed to everyone in the communities so that we can encourage volunteers
- Look to setting up a Spirituality Group and a Social Group – to help create better relationships across the New Parish
