APPOINTMENT AS CANON: Fr John was recently honoured to be informed of his appointment by Bishop Patrick as a Canon of the Chapter of St Barnabas Cathedral. This appointment will take place at the Cathedral on the evening of 7 December at a celebration of Vespers on the Vigil of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The service will take place at 6.30pm and will be livestreamed. Any parishioner wishing to attend will be very welcome.
