MISSION APPEAL ON 18/19 NOVEMBER: The Comboni Missionaries (Verona Fathers) are a specifically missionary Order of priests and lay-brothers who were founded in 1867 by recently canonised St. Daniel Comboni. Today they live and work in four continents and some forty different countries worldwide.
