THE SEASON OF LENT BEGINS ON ASH WEDNESDAY 14 FEBRUARY: It is a season of Prayer, Fasting and charity giving. It's we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving charity; and we practice self-control through fasting.

Encountering the Lord - when we take the opportunity to go to Mass, Holy Hour, Capacitar, Scripture Sharing, and reading Scripture.

Serving the Lord - by serving others - giving my time to helping others, to sit and listen to others, to give to Charity.

Following the Lord - thinking of what Jesus would do rather than what I want to do - for example fasting from food but also fasting from being selfish, from being critical, being angry, using hurtful words, from complaining...

Why not decide this Lent - instead of giving up something - DO something e.g. every evening say thank you to the Lord for 10 things e.g. a roof over my head; food to eat; safe at the end of the day.....etc... OR - choose one of the Gospels and read a chapter each day; decide to take 10 mins quiet each day..
